ENTERING SERVICE HOURS

To enter Summer hours, go to the website and click on the GOOGLE form. We do not accept hours for non-Interact sponsored events. You may log other hours in your separate resume document, or see an Exec Board member about future sponsorship for an activity. You may also wait til the end of a repeating activity (like Computer Classes for Sr Citizens) to enter hours.

Requirements for Service Recognition

In order to earn a pin/certificate, you must

- have 30+ hrs of service from Interact events during that school year.
- be a committee head for at least one event.
- attend at least 70% of Monday meetings
- attend a Leadership Conference (ex. RYLA, Blanket Making, NNHS Conference, Girl Scout Workshop, or other pre-approved option).

Awards: See our website for our certificate program to earn a bronze, silver, and gold certificate at the banquet. Hours and requirements accumulate throughout your 4 years of high school. Please fill in the Google form when you have completed any of following:

- BRONZE: earn 30 hours of community service.
- SILVER: earn 50 hours, head a committee.
- GOLD: earn 100 hours of service, head a committee, attend a leadership conference, and attend at least 10 Interact meetings.
